PROJECT EXAMPLES

Patagonia Mountains, AZ: Led five years of surveys and monitoring for the yellow-billed cuckoo, Mexican spotted owl, and northern goshawk in 30 miles of rugged habitat. Trained client biologists in proper survey methods.
